**Before we gather together for
a flurry of assemblage construction...
Start setting aside these materials.**

****None of these items need to be new, if they are not available
from your home or garage-visit goodwill, garage sales or borrow from a neighbor!**

**2 used wooden boxes or drawers-no larger than 12",
with some depth, 2-4", or purchased shadowbox.**

**Screwdrivers-small assortment of sizes-flathead and phillips
Assortment of screws and nails-different sizes and types,
small diameter for the nails, 20 or so**

Scissors, pliers, wirecutters and razor/exacto knife

Hammer-small if available

**Brushes-Small assortment for painting background or details.
Maximum size 1 1/2".**

Bits of wire.

**Small pc. of scrap plywood or kitchen cutting board-
For table top cutting and hammering.**

Begin putting aside some of your favorite flotsam and jetsam of life
that has accumulated in junk & jewelry drawers, coffee cans
and in my case, the corners of my living and dining room!

Some ideas for doo-dads to include, but not limit yourself to:

Buttons, hinges, keys, bits of jewelry and watches, random pc's of metal,
screening and mesh, bottlecaps-soda and otherwise, bits of wire and string,
small stones, beads, small pc's driftwood, old game pc's,
small bottles and cast-off metal containers, small frames.

Don't forget to bring paper ephemera: tickets, book parts, sheet music,
favorite paper, images, etc.
