A separate check of \$10 "for handling" payable to NORTHWIND ARTS CENTER should be included for each shipped piece.

ART PORT TOWNSEND will return shipped artwork via UPS OR FEDEX if it is accompanied by a check also paid to the order of NORTHWIND ARTS CENTER in the full amount of the charges, including pickup charges. A return address label must be attached with specific instructions regarding the value to be placed on the art piece. All shipping charges and transit insurance are the responsibility of the artist! If artwork is to be returned via trucking or Airfreight Company, this information must be clearly indicated. Please include an 800 number so we can arrange for pickup.

Although the utmost care will be taken in the handling of your artwork, Northwind Arts Center will not be held responsible for damage or loss from any cause during the delivery of artwork, or during the show.

LOCAL ARTIST SELECTED

The work of local artist, ARTIST NAME, has been selected to be included in ART PORT TOWNSEND/EXPRESSIONS NORTHWEST, the Northwind Arts Center and Port Townsend Arts Commission's 19th Annual Juried Art Exhibition. It will be held Aug 3 – August 27, 2017 in the beautiful Seaport town of Port Townsend, Washington.

Juror **Susan Warner** has over thirty years of management, arts administration, and museum education experience. Susan is the Executive Director at Vashon Center for the Arts. Prior to this, Susan was at Museum of Glass in Tacoma, where she had curatorial, education, and Hot Shop responsibilities, and served as the museum's major gifts officer. Warner was also responsible for overseeing the organization of major exhibitions that are designed to travel across the country. This includes managing the production of fully researched and illustrated catalogs in partnership with the University of Washington Press. Warner was Director of Education at the Seattle Children's Museum. She also served as Curator of Education at the State Capital Museum in Olympia, and as Assistant Curator, Curator of Decorative Arts at the Dayton Art Institute. Her early career included extensive curatorial work in collection management and exhibition development. In 1997, she received Washington State's Gold Apple Award for Excellence in Education and, in 1998, she accepted a Coming Up Taller award for her program, The Experimental Gallery. **Susan has selected 67 pieces from 303 works of art submitted.
